- **SumUp POS Pro account**
(pos.thegoodtill.com)
You should have received an email to activate this shortly after paying for your order
- **SumUp Merchant/Payments account**
(me.sumup.com)
This is the SumUp account used to configure your Kiosk and take payments



Kiosk Portal - Setup Steps

Rename the Default Location & Assign POS Connection



Locations allow you to add and configure terminals in one or multiple locations, in case you have more than one.

A “Default Location” is created with the account, in which you can add the necessary terminals.

The location can be renamed after your site’s physical location, such as “London Shop”.

Configure your Price Books

Price books allow your customers to order for *Eat in & Take away* or *Now & Later*.

If you only offer an immediate service, the Default price book is enough. If you'd also like to offer ordering to take away or for later, adding a secondary price book is necessary and should be named accordingly e.g. "Take away"

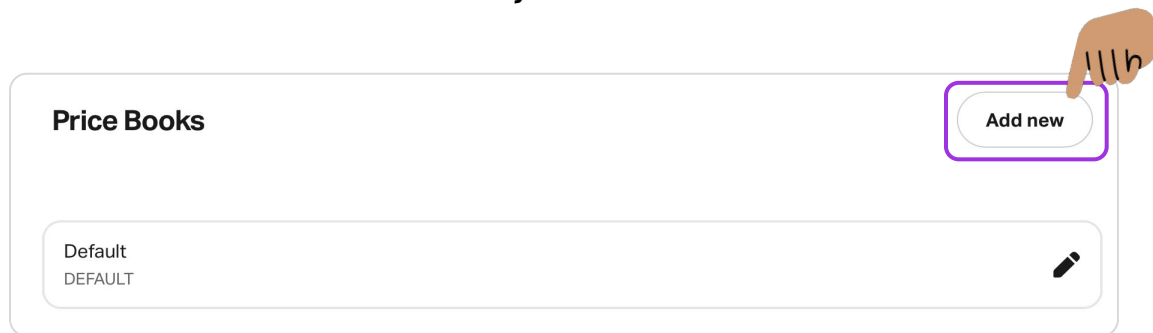

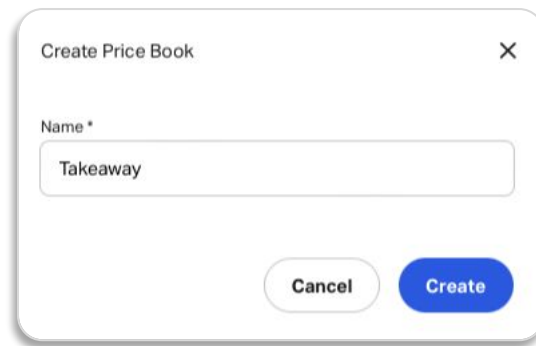

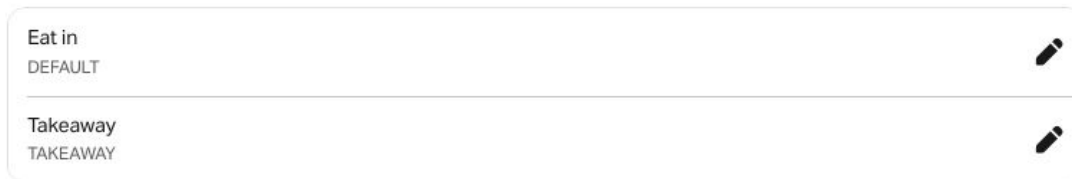
To add a Takeaway option, you'll need to add a new Price Book and name it "Takeaway" or similar

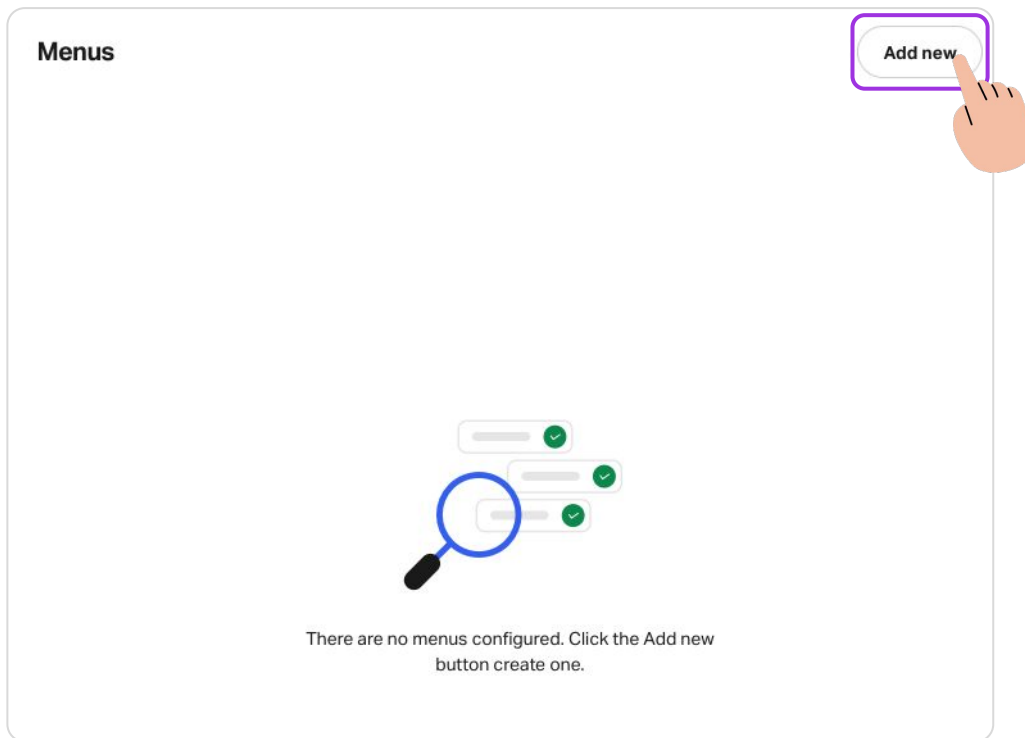

Create your Menu



The Menu is used to create the list of products displayed on your kiosk. A Menu is composed by “Sections” e.g. Hot Drinks, Soft Drinks, Breakfast, etc. You can then add the necessary items to each one of your Sections.


You have the ability to create multiple Menus and, depending on how your business operates, you can use the ***scheduled menus**** feature to automatically change layouts at specific times. For example, you can have a Layout for Breakfast and another one for Lunch & Dinner.

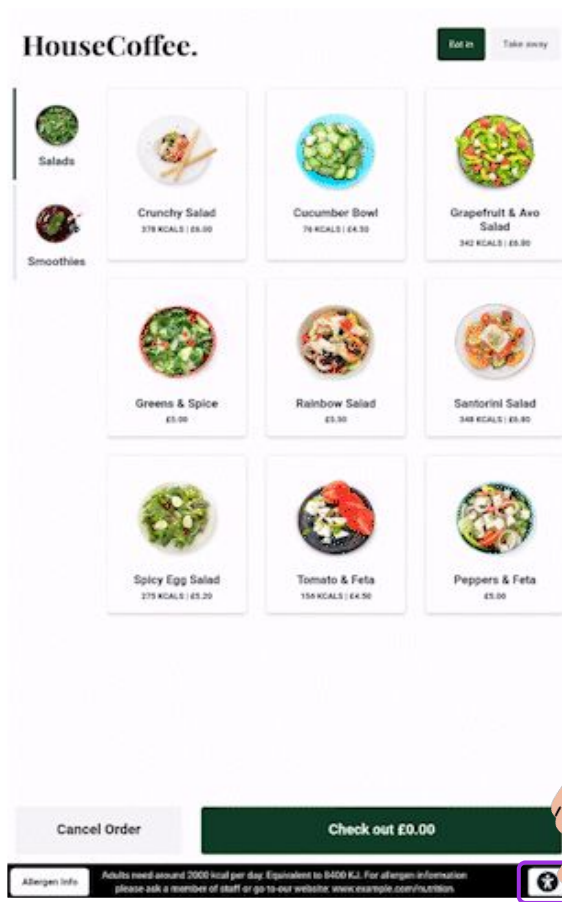

Background colour  **5** Background for pages outside of the menu. Not having a screensaver will display the background colour

Text  **3** Any text outside the primary colour buttons, except warning texts

Warning text colour  **6** Mainly affects the "Cancel" button when adding products

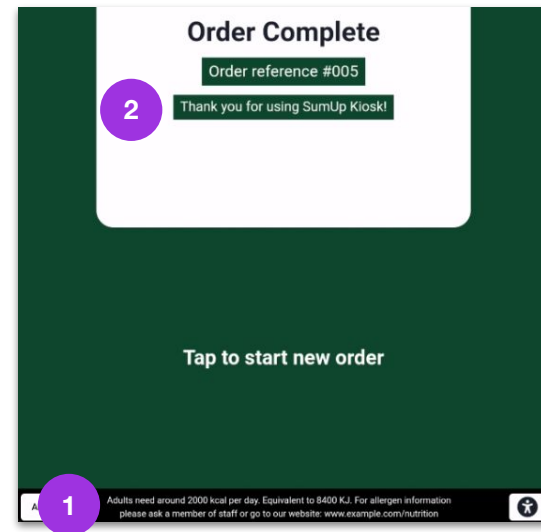

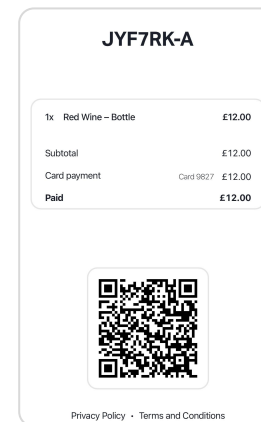

For physical receipts a **Star Micronics mC-Print3** printer can be connected to the Kiosk. Otherwise, please **disable**.
- 2 Show prices**
Enable "Show prices" to add item prices to your physical receipts. Leave disabled if you don't have a printer.
- 3 Use digital collection slips**
Enable "use digital collection slips" for digital receipts. The QR code will direct the customer to page with their order details. See example below.
